



### **Gerald O'Collins**

Born in Melbourne and ordained a priest in 1963, Gerald O'Collins spent 33 years teaching at the Gregorian University (Rome) where he was also dean of the theology faculty (1985-91).

As well as publishing hundreds of articles in popular and professional journals, he has so far authored or co-authored 70 books. The latest works include *Saint Augustine on the Resurrection of Christ* (Oxford University Press), *Lost in Translation* (Liturgical Press), and *Moments of Grace* (Fowler Wright).

Now resident at the Jesuit Theological College in Parkville, he continues to write books and articles and to lecture for various groups in Australia and overseas. He is well known around the world as a lecturer at many colleges and universities. As well as receiving numerous honorary doctorates and other awards, in 2006 he was a Companion of the General Division of the Order of Australia (AC), the highest civil honour granted through the Australian government.
