



### **Christopher Horvat**

An old scholar of Saint Ignatius' College, Adelaide, Christopher joined the Jesuits in February 1970.

He was ordained a priest at Saint Ignatius' Church, Norwood, in December 1982. A graduate of Monash University and the United Faculty of Theology, Parkville, he pursued postgraduate studies in Music at the University of Melbourne after ordination, while being Dean of Studies firstly at Newman College and then at Campion College, Kew.

His time has subsequently been divided between working in Jesuit schools in Sydney and Adelaide (where he was involved in many musical performances) and in administration at the General Curia in Rome and the Provincial Office in Melbourne.

Originally an accordionist and then a concert pianist for 30 years, he is currently living at Newman College, a Catholic residential college within the University of Melbourne, and working at the Provincial Office. He continues to research the life and music of Franz Liszt and maintains a keen interest in film.
